Reasons for the Decision

It is intended to adopt the Roman Circus Management Plan as a planning guidance document. The process of preparing a management plan involves seeking the views of a number of departments, agencies and individuals, and balancing their interests in making recommendations for the development of a site within the overall policy framework set by local and national planning policies. The weight afforded to a planning guidance document as a material consideration in determining any future planning application will increase if it has been prepared in consultation with the public and has been the subject of a Council resolution. Up grading the management plan to a supplementary planning document will further increase the weight afforded to the development brief.

Alternative Options

The alternative option is not to consult the public on the Roman Circus Management. Should this option be pursued, this would weaken the weight afforded to the Management Plan as a planning guidance and thereby potentially reduce the ability of the Council to shape the protection of the monument and it's setting from the pressures of damage and commercial interest
