Reasons for the Decision
The Housing Act 1985 specifies how local authorities must set interest rates on mortgages arranged since 3 October 1980. Authorities must charge whichever is the higher of:
The Standard National Rate (SNR), which is set by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, based on interest rates currently charged by various lenders; or The Locally Determined Rate (LDR), the applicable local average rate, based on the authority's own borrowing costs.
The Secretary of State last reduced the SNR of interest from 3.93% to 3.13% with effect from 1 April 2009, after taking into account trends in mortgage lending rates. No further notification about the SNR has been received.
The LDR has reduced to 3.08% and is lower than the SNR. The rate charged to borrowers must equal the proposed LDR plus 0.25% administrative costs equalling 3.33%.
