## 7.1 & 7.2 – Holy Trinity Church, Trinity Square, Colchester

With regard to the lighting, **Historic England** state “ On the basis of this information, we do not wish to offer any comments. We suggest that you seek the views of your specialist conservation and archaeological advisers, as relevant.”

**Highway Authority:** “our comments remain as previously submitted.”

**One further letter of objection** has been received, stating the following:

“Object to the proposal

Comment: Opening up the graveyard will simply add to the anti-social behaviour and noise in the area. The town

centre has many residential flats in that area and it is unacceptable to add to the noise and anti-social behaviour.

The open space will invite those who sell and purchase drugs even more than it does now. The grave yard is

historically significant and to turn it into a takeaway lunch eating area is not appropriate.”

### 7.4 – 4 St Botolphs Street, Colchester
